## Make a mini Edomaru kite

## What you need

- ◆Kite string (60 cm)
- ◆Bamboo strips (for tying the kite string to)
- ◆Sticky tape/glue
- ◆Scissors/penknife
- Hole punch or other perforating tool (for punching holes in the paper)
- ◆Sheets 1 and 2 printed out on A4 paper

Sheet 1: Print [Kite] (3 designs) and [Perforating guide] on thick paper (about the thickness of a postcard).

Sheet 2: Print [Tail] on regular paper.

## Sheet 1







Ask a grown-up to help you with the tricky bits!



## Steps:

- ① Cut along the cutting lines ( —— ) of Sheet 1 [Kite] (3 designs) and [Perforating guide], and Sheet 2 [Tail].
- ② Place the [Perforating guide] over a [Kite] card and use a hole punch or other perforating tool to punch a hole through the card. ← Ask a grown-up to help you!
- ③ From the side of the 【Kite】 card with the picture on it, thread the kite string through and tie a knot on the reverse side. Then, put sticky tape over the knotted string to hold it in place.
- ④ On the reverse side of the [Kite] card, attach one [Tail] to each side of the bottom of the card. (You can use sticky tape or glue.)
- (5) Take the other end of the kite string that you have threaded through the [Kite] card, wind it around the top of a bamboo strip, then tie a knot.
